FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the ages for participation in camp?

Summer Camp is offered to boys and girls ages 7-15. All skill levels are welcome.

How much does a Milwaukee Bucks Summer Camp cost?

Summer Camp prices may vary depending on length of camp (4-day or 5-day), whether the camp is a full-day or half-day, as well as other factors. You can view the price for each Summer Camp in the Summer Camp registration page under the Complete List of Summer Camps section.

What does a typical Summer Camp day look like?

A Summer Camp schedule rundown has been posted in the Summer Camps page.

What does my kid need to bring to Summer Camp?

All campers should bring a refillable water bottle, and full-day campers should bring a bagged lunch. If your child needs any medication while they are at camp, please inform the camp director, and he will hold on to the medicine during the day. Your child can bring a backpack to camp, but please leave all valuables at home.

What does my kid wear to Summer Camp?

Campers should come to camp dressed in athletic attire (-shirt, athletic shorts, and gym shoes). Bucks gear is encouraged! We will also provide performance tee to all participants.

Do I need to bring a basketball to camp?

You do not need to bring a basketball to camp. We will provide an appropriately-sized basketball to each camper that they get to take home at the end of the week.

Do I need to provide a lunch for my child?

Yes, please plan on packing a lunch for your child if enrolled in a Full Day Camp. We will have a lunch break at 12:00-1:00 daily, except on Fridays. If your child has an allergy, we will monitor an area for them to enjoy their lunch in. If you did not include allergy information during enrollment, please inform us at camps@bucks.com.

What are the hours of summer camp?

Full Day Camp runs Monday-Thursday 9am-4pm and Friday 9am-1pm unless otherwise noted.

Half Day Camp runs Monday-Thursday 9am-12pm and Friday 9am-1pm.

On Friday, all sessions will end at 1:00pm. The camp awards ceremony and Bucks Entertainment Network will begin approximately 12:00pm. Parents are welcome and encouraged to join us for the ceremony.



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What is the refund policy?

Unfortunately, we do not offer refunds on Summer Camp. If there is an unforeseen circumstance that impacts your child's ability to attend their week of camp, we will work on finding an alternative session that they can attend. Please email camps@bucks.com for accommodations.

How are the kids grouped together during camp?

On day one of camp, participants will be grouped together by age and skill level between two divisions. The camp director can make accommodations for requests to be moved up or down between the two divisions.

What does the camp entail?

Bucks Summer Camps are directed toward teaching the fundamentals of basketball. Kids will play and learn through developing skills in dribbling, passing, shooting, rebounding, defense, teamwork, and more through various games, drills, and scrimmages. There are full-day and half-day camps available. To see the full list, please visit the Summer Camps page.

On the last day of camp, parents are encouraged to join their child at the *End of Camp Ceremony* to celebrate the end of camp and all the hard work put in by their child. The ceremony is expected to start approximately 12:00pm but is subject to change. Please contact the camp director if you have any questions regarding the End of Camp Ceremony.

How many campers attend a Summer Camp?

Attendance varies due to different sizes of our gym sites. In general, camps generally range from 50-100 campers.

Who does the coaching?

Our camp staff is comprised of current and former players from the professional and collegiate level as well as local area high school. Our professional camp coaches are selected for their basketball knowledge and ability to teach kids of all ages and skill levels. What does my child receive for participating?

Your child will receive a uniquely Bucks experience that teaches the fundamentals of basketball and focuses on skill improvement. The program is rich in sportsmanship and teamwork. After

the End of Camp Ceremony, photography with the Bucks Entertainment Network varies by location, but campers will have an opportunity to take photos at our player backdrop photo booth.

On the first day of Summer Camp, kids will receive a performance tee that they can wear to camp. After the Friday awards ceremony, your child will receive a pennant, a folder, a basketball, and an evaluation card. Each camper also receives a ticket to select Bucks games in the 2020-2021 season.*

*Ticket subject to availability and available games will be selected by the Milwaukee Bucks. Ticket purchase option opens on October 8, 2020.
