

Who should attend camp?

Bucks Summer Camps are designed for children ages 7-14. All skill levels are welcome!

How much does it cost to attend a Milwaukee Bucks Summer Camp?

Summer Camp prices may vary depending on length of camp (4-day or 5-day) and location, whether the camp is a full-day or half-day, as well as other factors. View the price for each Summer Camp in the Summer Camp registration page under the <u>Complete List of Summer Camps</u> section.

What does a typical Summer Camp day look like?

What should my child bring to Summer Camp?

All campers should bring a refillable water bottle and full-day campers should bring a bagged lunch. If your child needs any medication while they are at camp, please inform the Camp Director. Your child can bring a backpack to camp, but please leave all valuables at home.

What should my child wear to Summer Camp?

Campers should come to camp dressed in athletic attire (t-shirt, athletic shorts, and gym shoes). Bucks gear is encouraged! All participants will receive a t-shirt on the final day of camp.

Do I need to bring a basketball to camp?

You do not need to bring a basketball to camp. We will provide an appropriately-sized basketball for each camper that they will get to take home at the end of the week.

Do I need to provide a lunch for my child?

Yes, please plan on packing a lunch for your child if they are enrolled in a Full Day Camp. We will have a lunch break from 12-1pm daily, except on Friday. If your child has an allergy, we will provide an area for them to safely enjoy their lunch in. If you did not include allergy information during enrollment, please alert the Camp Director at camps@bucks.com.

What are the Bucks Summer Camp hours?

Full Day Camps run Monday-Thursday 9am-3pm and Friday 9am-1pm unless otherwise noted.

Half Day Camps run Monday-Thursday 9am-12pm and Friday 9am-1pm.

On Friday, the camp awards ceremony will begin approximately at 12pm. Parents/guardians are encouraged to attend the ceremony.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the refund policy?

We do not offer refunds on Bucks Summer Camp. If there is an unforeseen circumstance that impacts your child's ability to attend their week of camp, we will work on finding an alternative session that they can attend. Please email camps@bucks.com for accommodations.

How are the kids grouped together during camp?

On day one of camp, participants will be grouped together by grade and skill level between two divisions. The camp director can make accommodations for requests to be moved up or down between the two divisions.

What does the camp entail?

Bucks Summer Camps teach the fundamentals of basketball. Kids will play and learn through developing skills in dribbling, passing, shooting, rebounding, defense, teamwork, and more. The format includes games, drills and scrimmages. There are full-day and half-day camps available. To see the full list, please visit the Summer Camps page.

On the last day of Bucks Summer Camp, parents/guardians are encouraged to join their child at the *End of Camp Ceremony*. The ceremony is expected to start at 12pm, but is subject to change. Please contact the Camp Director if you have any questions regarding the End of Camp Ceremony.

How many campers attend a Summer Camp?

Attendance varies based on the size of the gym sites. Camps generally range from 60-150 campers.

Who coaches the Bucks Summer Camps?

Our camp staff is comprised of current and former players from the professional and collegiate level as well as local high school coaches. Our professional camp coaches are selected for their basketball knowledge and ability to teach kids of all ages and skill levels.
